Given her creativity and her broad range of artistic interests, she has been studying various different fields of art from an early age, always focusing on processing and experimenting with different materials.

In 1989, she painted and marbled silk fabrics which were then used to produce images and sacred cloths as well as being applied in interior design. She shared this knowledge with others for many years through various courses.

From 1992 to 1997, Monika Bidner took lessons with the Columbian ceramics artist María del Pilar Suárez Castillo and began to focus intensively on clay objects and glazing.

Inspired by a painting trip to Italy in 2009, she began to turn increasingly to painting and discovered her own unique technique which she primarily uses in her works today.

Acrylic images are created with a unique surface design using structural pastes and gels and various natural materials such as wood, bark, metal, wire, melted glass, silk fabrics, etc.

In 2009, Monika Bidner exhibited her works in public for the first time. This was followed by several group and individual exhibitions both in Austria and abroad.
